Job Summary

The Financial Accounting Manager is primarily responsible for leading a team of bookkeepers and ensuring that all transactional accounting processes are performed accurately and on a timely basis. The role is a senior member of the Finance team, reporting into the Financial Controller of Graceway Supermarkets, and is expected the play a leadership role in the continuous development of the finance team, accounting systems and our financial processes to improve our efficiency, our ways of working, and our financial controls.

Key Duties/Responsibilities

- Responsible for the overall management of colleagues within the Financial Accounting team, promoting effective
 prioritization of workloads, delegation, professional development, cross training, and talent succession planning. Ensure
 appropriate resources and team culture are in place to deliver a high standard of accuracy and that resources are efficiently
 utilized.
- Responsible for managing all transactional accounting processes within the Financial Accounting Team, including accounts payable, accounts receivable, weekly payroll, cash reconciliations and sales reporting.
- Responsible for managing detailed review and reconciliation of general ledger accounts on a regular basis to ensure
 accuracy of accounting records.
- Detailed review of weekly payments to local and international vendors as well as weekly payroll cheques.
- Preparation of best-in-class, accurate and timely balance sheet reconciliations. Investigation and proactive resolution of all significant reconciling differences.
- Monthly review of receivable balances and determining action required in relation to overdue balances.
- Timely and accurate contribution to the preparation of financial analysis, forecasts, budgets, cashflows and other key management information as required.
- Promptly respond to credit card chargeback queries as required.
- Ensure the team are encouraged in their learning and development needs, setting objectives, coaching, and providing constructive feedback through regular one-to-ones.
- Continuously work to implement and improve accounting processes and procedures to drive team and business efficiencies, improving control and insight for the business and reducing workloads and the risk of errors
- Support the audit process to ensure an efficient and clean annual audit.
- Be an ERP and Finance system super-user, and the Finance go-to person for business-led projects that impact on the Financial Accounting Team.
- Support or lead other ad-hoc accounting related projects as required.
- Drive control and improvements to processes and utilization of the finance system.
